
Financial Report

For the year ending December 31, 2019

Generous donations, sponsorships, and more for the 2019 year totaled \$51,813.53. However, Brave Hearts for Strong Minds incurred a loss of \$1,295.80. The loss was covered by previous funds saved throughout our first seven years of operations. It is important to note that overall cost for each category listed in the table below were significantly reduced compared to 2018. Additionally, several large donations were not processed until after January 1, 2020. We are working to keep reducing costs for 2020 and to expand our fundraising capabilities outside of the annual walk in June.

Reflecting on Tom's compassion and friendship, each year, the Saturday before Father's Day, BHSM holds a charity walk. All proceeds from the walk will go towards the 529 education plans of Amanda's three children, Evan (4), and twins Dylan (3) and Stella (3) (pictured right).

Amanda personified everything that prompted the community to start Brave Hearts for Strong Minds. We cannot possibly hope to heal the hole in the Moher family's hearts. But as a community we can offer support to Evan, Dylan, and Stella, by helping to make the education their mother would have wanted for them possible.
